The use of 'Worship' in the Bible.

Note:

The true Biblical meaning of Worship requires each of the spiritual gifts of knowledge, wisdom and understanding to comprehend properly. Understanding can show the similarities and differences found within verses of the Bible that tell us about worship. The verses that tell us about worship actually involve far more of the Bible than just the few verses that use the word of worship, but this paper only deals with the verses which use the word of worship. As we study these verses, we find that true worship is deeply personal and, therefore, is very much involved in the gift of knowledge. However, in addition to being something done privately, worship is also done publicly. Further, there are many verses which warn us of the consequences of wrong worship. Therefore, God expects His preachers, who have the spiritual gift of wisdom, to use that gift and teach His people how to properly worship God. In consideration of all of that, it needs to be acknowledged that this paper only provides the most basic level of Understanding how God uses the word worship within the Bible. In fact, while each verse was considered in context and according to sentence structure, those notes were not written up and provided here. That expansion may occur at a future date.

The best example of Biblical worship , that I can think of, is that <u>Isaiah 6:1</u> says In the year that king Uzziah died I saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple. The entire tone of the message from Isaiah changed at this verse. When Isaiah personally saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple , he was personally changed in his innermost person. True Biblical worship is supposed to have this personal effect upon each of us. However, I lack the wisdom required to teach someone else how they can receive this personal revelation. Hopefully, the Holy Spirit can use this basic definition to motivate others to study further and receive the required revelation from God. May God grant you the personal ability to truly worship Him like Isaiah did. The definition from Webster �s 1828 dictionary is provided and should be read for a basic definition of the word worship . Please keep in mind that this is an English dictionary and, therefore, may include definitions used by man but not used by God within His Word.

Worship-Outline

- 1. Worship is a personal act that often requires personal sacrifice. - When a representative of the God of the Bible accepts worship that shows that the being is actually God. When the being refuses worship that shows that the being is Godly but is not God. (Joshua 5:14; Matthew 8:2; 9:18; 14:33; 15:25; 20:20; 28:9, 17; Mark 5:6; John 4:23, 24; 9:38; Acts 10:25; Hebrews 1:6; Revelation 19:10; 22:8, 9)
- 3. People who don �t belong to God don �t understand true worship of God. (<u>2 Kings 18:22</u>; <u>2 Chronicles 32:12</u>; <u>Isaiah 36:7</u>; <u>John 4:22</u>; <u>Acts 17:23</u>, <u>25</u>; <u>Colossians 2:18</u>, <u>23</u>)
- 4. Sometimes worship is applied to people to mean the actions of true worship without the

aspects that mean deity. Often these applications are false and used to get an advantage or to avoid just punishment. (<u>Matthew 18:26</u>; <u>Luke 14:10</u>)

- 5. Some people claim that they are worshipping when they are lying and only putting on an outward show. These liars do not live a life of obedience to God Is commands. They claim one thing in their I worship I and live another. (<u>1 Samuel 15:30</u>, <u>31</u>; <u>2 Kings 5:18</u>; <u>10:19</u>, <u>21</u>, <u>22</u>, <u>23</u>; Jeremiah 26:2; <u>44:19</u>; <u>Matthew 2:8</u>; <u>15:9</u>; <u>Mark 7:7</u>; <u>15:19</u>; <u>Revelation 3:9</u>)
- Worship is done in response to realizing the presence of God. (<u>Exodus 33:10</u>; <u>Joshua 5:14</u>; <u>2 Chronicles 7:3</u>; <u>Isaiah 49:7</u>; <u>Luke 24:52</u>)
- 7. Worship is done in response to realizing a personal attribute of God [mercy, grace, power, etc]. (<u>Exodus 34:8</u>; <u>Psalms 99:5</u>, <u>9</u>; <u>Isaiah 2:20</u>; <u>6:1</u>; <u>Revelation 15:4</u>)
- Worship is done in response to realizing a (received or promised) blessing from God. (<u>Genesis 24:48</u>, <u>52</u>; <u>Exodus 4:31</u>; <u>12:27</u>; <u>2 Chronicles 20:18</u>; <u>Psalms 45:11</u>; <u>86:9</u>; <u>138:2</u>; <u>Luke 24:52</u>). Also see verses below for revival (point 10).
- 9. Worship is done in response to receiving a personal command or judgment from God. (Judges 7:15; <u>1 Samuel 1:28</u>; <u>2 Samuel 12:20</u>)
- 10.Worship is to be done when we need a personal command or judgment from God. (<u>2</u><u>Samuel 15:32</u>; <u>Job 1:20</u>; <u>Psalms 5:7</u>; <u>22:29</u>; <u>John 9:31</u>)
- 11.Worship is done before starting a (great) work for God. (<u>1 Chronicles 29:20</u>; <u>Psalms 132:7</u>)
- 12.Worship does not make us saved (<u>Hebrews 10</u>). Worship is done as a result of true revival / conversion but a result is not the cause. (<u>2 Chronicles 29:28-30</u>; <u>Nehemiah 8:6</u>; <u>9:3</u>, <u>6</u>; <u>Psalms 22:27</u>; <u>29:2</u>; <u>66:4</u>; <u>95:6</u>; <u>96:9</u>; <u>Isaiah 27:13</u>; <u>66:23</u>; <u>Micah 5:13</u>; <u>Zechariah 14:16</u>; <u>1Corinthians 14:25</u>; <u>Hebrews 10:2</u>). Also see the verses of the next point. In Daniel 2:46Daniel allowed ♦ the king Nebuchadnezzar fell upon his face, and worshipped Daniel ♦ and Daniel was not part of the next chapter (Daniel 3). Daniel only came back into the story after getting this thing right.
- 14. Worship can be given to things/beings other than God. This ALWAYS results in punishment and often the punishment is put upon the children and followers of those who worship any being other than the God of the Bible. (Exodus 32:8; 34:14; Deuteronomy 4:19; 8:19; 11:16; 17:3; 29:26; 30:17; 1 Kings 9:6, 9; 11:33; 12:30; 16:31; 22:53; 2 Kings 17:16; 19:37; 21:3, 21; 2 Chronicles 7:19; 7:22; 33:3; Psalms 97:7; 106:19; Isaiah 2:8; 37:38; 44:15, 17; 46:6; Jeremiah 1:16; 8:2; 13:10; 16:11; 22:9; 25:6; 44:19; Ezekiel 8:16; Daniel 3:5, 6, 7, 10, 11, 12, 14, 15; Zephaniah 1:5; 2:11; Matthew 4:9; Luke 4:7; Acts 7:42; 7:43; 19:27, 35; Romans 1:25) In particular, the devil and all who follow him want to be worshipped as God. (2 Thessalonians 2:4). Those who do so will be damned by God (2 Thessalonians 2:7-12; Revelation 9:20; 13:4, 8, 12, 15; 14:9, 11; 16:2; 19:20).

- <u>Genesis 22:5</u> And Abraham said unto his young men, Abide ye here with the ass; and I and the lad will go yonder and **worship**, and come again to you.
- Genesis 24:26 And the man bowed down his head, and worshipped the LORD.
- <u>Genesis 24:48</u> And I bowed down my head, and **worshipped** the LORD, and blessed the LORD God of my master Abraham, which had led me in the right way to take my master's brother's daughter unto his son.
- <u>Genesis 24:52</u> And it came to pass, that, when Abraham's servant heard their words, he **worshipped** the LORD, bowing himself to the earth.

- <u>1 Kings 22:53</u> For he served Baal, and **worshipped** him, and provoked to anger the LORD God of Israel, according to all that his father had done.

glory of the LORD upon the house, they bowed themselves with their faces to the ground upon the pavement, and **worshipped**, and praised the LORD, saying, For he is good; for his mercy endureth for ever.

- <u>2 Chronicles 7:19</u> But if ye turn away, and forsake my statutes and my commandments, which I have set before you, and shall go and serve other gods, and **worship** them;
- <u>2 Chronicles 7:22</u> And it shall be answered, Because they forsook the LORD God of their fathers, which brought them forth out of the land of Egypt, and laid hold on other gods, and **worshipped** them, and served them: therefore hath he brought all this evil upon them.
- <u>2 Chronicles 20:18</u> And Jehoshaphat bowed his head with his face to the ground: and all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem fell before the LORD, **worshipping** the LORD.
- <u>2 Chronicles 29:28</u> And all the congregation **worshipped**, and the singers sang, and the trumpeters sounded: and all this continued until the burnt offering was finished.
- <u>2 Chronicles 29:29</u> And when they had made an end of offering, the king and all that were present with him bowed themselves, and **worshipped**.
- <u>2 Chronicles 29:30</u> Moreover Hezekiah the king and the princes commanded the Levites to sing praise unto the LORD with the words of David, and of Asaph the seer. And they sang praises with gladness, and they bowed their heads and **worshipped**.
- <u>2 Chronicles 32:12</u> Hath not the same Hezekiah taken away his high places and his altars, and commanded Judah and Jerusalem, saying, Ye shall **worship** before one altar, and burn incense upon it?
- <u>2 Chronicles 33:3</u> For he built again the high places which Hezekiah his father had broken down, and he reared up altars for Baalim, and made groves, and **worshipped** all the host of heaven, and served them.
- <u>Nehemiah 8:6</u> And Ezra blessed the LORD, the great God. And all the people answered, Amen, Amen, with lifting up their hands: and they bowed their heads, and **worshipped** the LORD with their faces to the ground.

- <u>Isaiah 44:15</u> Then shall it be for a man to burn: for he will take thereof, and warm himself; yea, he kindleth it, and baketh bread; yea, he maketh a god, and **worship** peth it; he maketh it a graven image, and falleth down thereto.
- <u>Isaiah 44:17</u> And the residue thereof he maketh a god, even his graven image: he falleth down unto it, and **worshippeth** it, and prayeth unto it, and saith, Deliver me; for thou art my god.
- <u>Isaiah 46:6</u> They lavish gold out of the bag, and weigh silver in the balance, and hire a goldsmith; and he maketh it a god: they fall down, yea, they **worship**.
- <u>Isaiah 49:7</u> Thus saith the LORD, the Redeemer of Israel, and his Holy One, to him whom man despiseth, to him whom the nation abhorreth, to a servant of rulers, Kings shall see and arise, princes also shall **worship**, because of the LORD that is faithful, and the Holy One of Israel, and he shall choose thee.
- <u>Isaiah 66:23</u> And it shall come to pass, that from one new moon to another, and from one sabbath to another, shall all flesh come to **worship** before me, saith the LORD.
- Jeremiah 1:16 And I will utter my judgments against them touching all their wickedness, who have forsaken me, and have burned incense unto other gods, and worshipped the works of their own hands.
- <u>Jeremiah 7:2</u> Stand in the gate of the LORD'S house, and proclaim there this word, and say, Hear the word of the LORD, all ye of Judah, that enter in at these gates to **worship** the LORD.
- <u>Jeremiah 8:2</u> And they shall spread them before the sun, and the moon, and all the host of heaven, whom they have loved, and whom they have served, and after whom they have walked, and whom they have sought, and whom they have **worshipped** : they shall not be gathered, nor be buried; they shall be for dung upon the face of the earth.
- <u>Jeremiah 13:10</u> This evil people, which refuse to hear my words, which walk in the imagination of their heart, and walk after other gods, to serve them, and to **worship** them, shall even be as this girdle, which is good for nothing.

- Jeremiah 16:11 Then shalt thou say unto them, Because your fathers have forsaken me, saith the LORD, and have walked after other gods, and have served them, and have **worshipped** them, and have forsaken me, and have not kept my law;
- Jeremiah 22:9 Then they shall answer, Because they have forsaken the covenant of the LORD their God, and **worshipped** other gods, and served them.
- Jeremiah 25:6 And go not after other gods to serve them, and to **worship** them, and provoke me not to anger with the works of your hands; and I will do you no hurt.
- Jeremiah 26:2 Thus saith the LORD; Stand in the court of the LORD'S house, and speak unto all the cities of Judah, which come to **worship** in the LORD'S house, all the words that I command thee to speak unto them; diminish not a word:
- Jeremiah 44:19 And when we burned incense to the queen of heaven, and poured out drink offerings unto her, did we make her cakes to **worship** her, and pour out drink offerings unto her, without our men?
- <u>Ezekiel 8:16</u> And he brought me into the inner court of the LORD'S house, and, behold, at the door of the temple of the LORD, between the porch and the altar, were about five and twenty men, with their backs toward the temple of the LORD, and their faces toward the east; and they **worshipped** the sun toward the east.
- <u>Ezekiel 46:2</u> And the prince shall enter by the way of the porch of that gate without, and shall stand by the post of the gate, and the priests shall prepare his burnt offering and his peace offerings, and he shall **worship** at the threshold of the gate: then he shall go forth; but the gate shall not be shut until the evening.
- <u>Ezekiel 46:3</u> Likewise the people of the land shall **worship** at the door of this gate before the LORD in the sabbaths and in the new moons.
- <u>Ezekiel 46:9</u> But when the people of the land shall come before the LORD in the solemn feasts, he that entereth in by the way of the north gate to **worship** shall go out by the way of the south gate; and he that entereth by the way of the south gate shall go forth by the way of the north gate: he shall not return by the way of the gate whereby he came in, but shall go forth over against it.
- <u>Daniel 2:46</u> Then the king Nebuchadnezzar fell upon his face, and **worshipped** Daniel, and commanded that they should offer an oblation and sweet odours unto him.
- <u>Daniel 3:5</u> That at what time ye hear the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, dulcimer, and all kinds of musick, ye fall down and **worship** the golden image that Nebuchadnezzar the king hath set up:
- <u>Daniel 3:6</u> And whoso falleth not down and **worshippeth** shall the same hour be cast into the midst of a burning fiery furnace.
- <u>Daniel 3:7</u> Therefore at that time, when all the people heard the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, and all kinds of musick, all the people, the nations, and the languages, fell down and **worshipped** the golden image that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up.
- <u>Daniel 3:10</u> Thou, O king, hast made a decree, that every man that shall hear the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, and dulcimer, and all kinds of musick, shall fall down and **worship** the golden image:
- <u>Daniel 3:11</u> And whoso falleth not down and **worshippeth**, that he should be cast into the midst of a burning fiery furnace.
- <u>Daniel 3:12</u> There are certain Jews whom thou hast set over the affairs of the province of Babylon, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego; these men, O king, have not regarded thee: they serve not thy gods, nor **worship** the golden image which thou hast set up.
- <u>Daniel 3:14</u> Nebuchadnezzar spake and said unto them, Is it true, O Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, do not ye serve my gods, nor **worship** the golden image which I have set up?
- Daniel 3:15 Now if ye be ready that at what time ye hear the sound of the cornet, flute, harp,

sackbut, psaltery, and dulcimer, and all kinds of musick, ye fall down and **worship** the image which I have made; well: but if ye **worship** not, ye shall be cast the same hour into the midst of a burning fiery furnace; and who is that God that shall deliver you out of my hands?

- <u>Daniel 3:18</u> But if not, be it known unto thee, O king, that we will not serve thy gods, nor **worship** the golden image which thou hast set up.
- <u>Daniel 3:28</u> Then Nebuchadnezzar spake, and said, Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, who hath sent his angel, and delivered his servants that trusted in him, and have changed the king's word, and yielded their bodies, that they might not serve nor **worship** any god, except their own God.
- <u>Micah 5:13</u> Thy graven images also will I cut off, and thy standing images out of the midst of thee; and thou shalt no more **worship** the work of thine hands.
- Zephaniah 1:5 And them that **worship** the host of heaven upon the housetops; and them that **worship** and that swear by the LORD, and that swear by Malcham;
- Zephaniah 2:11 The LORD will be terrible unto them: for he will famish all the gods of the earth; and men shall **worship** him, every one from his place, even all the isles of the heathen.
- Zechariah 14:16 And it shall come to pass, that every one that is left of all the nations which came against Jerusalem shall even go up from year to year to worship the King, the LORD of hosts, and to keep the feast of tabernacles.
- Zechariah 14:17 And it shall be, that whoso will not come up of all the families of the earth unto Jerusalem to **worship** the King, the LORD of hosts, even upon them shall be no rain.
- <u>Matthew 2:2</u> Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews? for we have seen his star in the east, and are come to **worship** him.
- <u>Matthew 2:8</u> And he sent them to Bethlehem, and said, Go and search diligently for the young child; and when ye have found him, bring me word again, that I may come and **worship** him also.
- <u>Matthew 2:11</u> And when they were come into the house, they saw the young child with Mary his mother, and fell down, and **worshipped** him: and when they had opened their treasures, they presented unto him gifts; gold, and frankincense, and myrrh.
- <u>Matthew 4:9</u> And saith unto him, All these things will I give thee, if thou wilt fall down and **worship** me.
- <u>Matthew 4:10</u> Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt **worship** the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.
- <u>Matthew 8:2</u> And, behold, there came a leper and **worshipped** him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean.
- <u>Matthew 9:18</u> While he spake these things unto them, behold, there came a certain ruler, and **worshipped** him, saying, My daughter is even now dead: but come and lay thy hand upon her, and she shall live.
- <u>Matthew 14:33</u> Then they that were in the ship came and **worshipped** him, saying, Of a truth thou art the Son of God.
- <u>Matthew 15:9</u> But in vain they do **worship** me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.
- <u>Matthew 15:25</u> Then came she and **worshipped** him, saying, Lord, help me.
- <u>Matthew 18:26</u> The servant therefore fell down, and **worshipped** him, saying, Lord, have patience with me, and I will pay thee all.
- <u>Matthew 20:20</u> Then came to him the mother of Zebedee's children with her sons, **worshipping** him, and desiring a certain thing of him.
- <u>Matthew 28:9</u> And as they went to tell his disciples, behold, Jesus met them, saying, All hail. And they came and held him by the feet, and **worshipped** him.
- <u>Matthew 28:17</u> And when they saw him, they **worshipped** him: but some doubted.

- Mark 5:6 But when he saw Jesus afar off, he ran and worshipped him,
- <u>Mark 7:7</u> Howbeit in vain do they worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.
- <u>Mark 15:19</u> And they smote him on the head with a reed, and did spit upon him, and bowing their knees **worshipped** him.
- Luke 4:7 If thou therefore wilt worship me, all shall be thine.
- <u>Luke 4:8</u> And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind me, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt **worship** the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.
- <u>Luke 14:10</u> But when thou art bidden, go and sit down in the lowest room; that when he that bade thee cometh, he may say unto thee, Friend, go up higher: then shalt thou have **worship** in the presence of them that sit at meat with thee.
- Luke 24:52 And they worshipped him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy:
- John 4:20 Our fathers **worshipped** in this mountain; and ye say, that in Jerusalem is the place where men ought to **worship**.
- <u>John 4:21</u> Jesus saith unto her, Woman, believe me, the hour cometh, when ye shall neither in this mountain, nor yet at Jerusalem, **worship** the Father.
- John 4:22 Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship : for salvation is of the Jews.
- John 4:23 But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true **worshippers** shall **worship** the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to **worship** him.
- John 4:24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.
- John 9:31 Now we know that God heareth not sinners: but if any man be a **worshipper** of God, and doeth his will, him he heareth.
- John 9:38 And he said, Lord, I believe. And he worshipped him.
- John 12:20 And there were certain Greeks among them that came up to **worship** at the feast:
- <u>Acts 7:42</u> Then God turned, and gave them up to **worship** the host of heaven; as it is written in the book of the prophets, O ye house of Israel, have ye offered to me slain beasts and sacrifices by the space of forty years in the wilderness?
- <u>Acts 7:43</u> Yea, ye took up the tabernacle of Moloch, and the star of your god Remphan, figures which ye made to **worship** them: and I will carry you away beyond Babylon.
- <u>Acts 8:27</u> And he arose and went: and, behold, a man of Ethiopia, an eunuch of great authority under Candace queen of the Ethiopians, who had the charge of all her treasure, and had come to Jerusalem for to **worship**,
- <u>Acts 10:25</u> And as Peter was coming in, Cornelius met him, and fell down at his feet, and **worshipped** him.
- <u>Acts 16:14</u> And a certain woman named Lydia, a seller of purple, of the city of Thyatira, which **worshipped** God, heard us: whose heart the Lord opened, that she attended unto the things which were spoken of Paul.
- <u>Acts 17:23</u> For as I passed by, and beheld your devotions, I found an altar with this inscription, TO THE UNKNOWN GOD. Whom therefore ye ignorantly **worship**, him declare I unto you.
- <u>Acts 17:25</u> Neither is **worshipped** with men's hands, as though he needed any thing, seeing he giveth to all life, and breath, and all things;
- <u>Acts 18:7</u> And he departed thence, and entered into a certain man's house, named Justus, one that **worshipped** God, whose house joined hard to the synagogue.
- <u>Acts 18:13</u> Saying, This fellow persuadeth men to **worship** God contrary to the law.
- <u>Acts 19:27</u> So that not only this our craft is in danger to be set at nought; but also that the temple of the great goddess Diana should be despised, and her magnificence should be destroyed, whom all Asia and the world **worshippeth**.

- <u>Acts 19:35</u> And when the townclerk had appeased the people, he said, Ye men of Ephesus, what man is there that knoweth not how that the city of the Ephesians is a **worshipper** of the great goddess Diana, and of the image which fell down from Jupiter?
- <u>Acts 24:11</u> Because that thou mayest understand, that there are yet but twelve days since I went up to Jerusalem for to **worship**.
- <u>Acts 24:14</u> But this I confess unto thee, that after the way which they call heresy, so **worship** I the God of my fathers, believing all things which are written in the law and in the prophets:
- <u>Romans 1:25</u> Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and **worshipped** and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen.
- <u>1 Corinthians 14:25</u> And thus are the secrets of his heart made manifest; and so falling down on his face he will **worship** God, and report that God is in you of a truth.
- <u>Philippians 3:3</u> For we are the circumcision, which **worship** God in the spirit, and rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh.
- <u>Colossians 2:18</u> Let no man beguile you of your reward in a voluntary humility and **worshipping** of angels, intruding into those things which he hath not seen, vainly puffed up by his fleshly mind,
- <u>Colossians 2:23</u> Which things have indeed a shew of wisdom in will **worship**, and humility, and neglecting of the body; not in any honour to the satisfying of the flesh.
- <u>2 Thessalonians 2:4</u> Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is **worshipped**; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, shewing himself that he is God.
- <u>Hebrews 1:6</u> And again, when he bringeth in the firstbegotten into the world, he saith, And let all the angels of God **worship** him.
- <u>Hebrews 10:2</u> For then would they not have ceased to be offered? because that the **worshippers** once purged should have had no more conscience of sins.
- <u>Hebrews 11:21</u> By faith Jacob, when he was a dying, blessed both the sons of Joseph; and **worshipped**, leaning upon the top of his staff.
- <u>Revelation 3:9</u> Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of Satan, which say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie; behold, I will make them to come and **worship** before thy feet, and to know that I have loved thee.
- <u>Revelation 4:10</u> The four and twenty elders fall down before him that sat on the throne, and **worship** him that liveth for ever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying,
- <u>Revelation 5:14</u> And the four beasts said, Amen. And the four and twenty elders fell down and **worshipped** him that liveth for ever and ever.
- <u>Revelation 7:11</u> And all the angels stood round about the throne, and about the elders and the four beasts, and fell before the throne on their faces, and **worshipped** God,
- <u>Revelation 9:20</u> And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not **worship** devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk:
- <u>Revelation 11:1</u> And there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of God, and the altar, and them that **worship** therein.
- <u>Revelation 11:16</u> And the four and twenty elders, which sat before God on their seats, fell upon their faces, and **worshipped** God,
- <u>Revelation 13:4</u> And they **worshipped** the dragon which gave power unto the beast: and they **worshipped** the beast, saying, Who is like unto the beast? who is able to make war with him?
- <u>Revelation 13:8</u> And all that dwell upon the earth shall **worship** him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.
- <u>Revelation 13:12</u> And he exerciseth all the power of the first beast before him, and causeth the earth and them which dwell therein to **worship** the first beast, whose deadly wound was

healed.

- <u>Revelation 13:15</u> And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not **worship** the image of the beast should be killed.
- <u>Revelation 14:7</u> Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and **worship** him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.
- <u>Revelation 14:9</u> And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man **worship** the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand,
- <u>Revelation 14:11</u> And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who **worship** the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name.
- <u>Revelation 15:4</u> Who shall not fear thee, O Lord, and glorify thy name? for thou only art holy: for all nations shall come and **worship** before thee; for thy judgments are made manifest.
- <u>Revelation 16:2</u> And the first went, and poured out his vial upon the earth; and there fell a noisome and grievous sore upon the men which had the mark of the beast, and upon them which **worshipped** his image.
- <u>Revelation 19:4</u> And the four and twenty elders and the four beasts fell down and **worshipped** God that sat on the throne, saying, Amen; Alleluia.
- <u>Revelation 19:10</u> And I fell at his feet to **worship** him. And he said unto me, See thou do it not: I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren that have the testimony of Jesus: **worship** God: for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.
- <u>Revelation 19:20</u> And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that **worshipped** his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.
- <u>Revelation 20:4</u> And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not **worshipped** the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.
- <u>Revelation 22:8</u> And I John saw these things, and heard them. And when I had heard and seen, I fell down to **worship** before the feet of the angel which shewed me these things.
- <u>Revelation 22:9</u> Then saith he unto me, See thou do it not: for I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren the prophets, and of them which keep the sayings of this book: **worship** God.
