Well, the rainy season is back on us. The dust is all gone and the mud is here for a while. Our roads are not in the best condition right now, but they have been much worse in the past, so we are not complaining.

A few weeks ago there was another attack on the Valley Road. The driver of the gas delivery truck was attacked in the same place that Vicki and I were two years ago. He was stopped at gunpoint, pulled from the truck and severely beaten. The gunmen took his money and left him for dead on the side of the road. Later, he was found by another man and taken to the hospital. He suffered severe head injuries and permanent damage to his left eye.

Our ministry is going well. We have seen three adults and three teens saved in the last four weeks. Just the other day, I heard someone at the gate. It was Francisco and Judith, a young couple that started attending our services a few months ago. They had recently enrolled their daughter in our feeding program. They told me the only reason they started attending services was because it is required to belong to the program. They said they started coming and liked the teaching on Sunday nights. The more they listened... the more interested they became. As they sat at my kitchen table that day, they said, "Mr. Dan, we want to be saved, we want to be baptized, and we want to do the right thing by getting married." Imagine that. All this just because we took the time to feed their eight-year old daughter lunch. Over the past several years, we have seen the lives of several families completely changed through our feeding program.

Vicki's condition has not changed. We have seen no improvements. Her short-term memory is getting a little worse. But she still never complains. We are both still thankful to have each other, still thankful to be on the field, still doing what we were called to do. And all of that is possible because of you. We know that we could never continue to do what God has called us to do... without you.
